







Valley Green Energy is a new electricity supply program that gives residents and businesses in Amherst, Northampton, and Pelham more choice and control over how we power our communities. The program is a group electricity purchasing program that changes the electricity supply price on your electric bill. Nearly 200 other cities and towns in Massachusetts have similar programs.

Using the bulk buying power of our communities, Valley Green Energy provides:

- More renewable energy for less than your electric utility's current electricity supply price.
- Three electricity choices.
- Stable and consistent pricing.

Valley Green Energy has three options.

Choose the one that's right for you.

New program participants will be automatically enrolled in VGE Standard Green. VGE 100% Green and VGE Basic are available by request. Choose online or by phone.

VGE BASIC 13.594 ¢/kWh Minimum required from renewable sources

Prices are fixed until November 2026.

Note that Eversource's and National Grid's future prices are unknown, so future savings cannot be guaranteed.

Most Amherst, Northampton, and Pelham electricity customers will be eligible for automatic enrollment.

 Have Eversource's or National Grid's Basic Service?

If you did not sign a private electricity supply contract, your account will be eligible for automatic enrollment, and you will receive a notification in the mail from your City or Town. Similar programs throughout the state use an automatic enrollment model, but you are free to opt out before being automatically enrolled.

How Valley Green Energy Works

Valley Green Energy changes your electricity supplier and the price that your electric utility uses to calculate the supply charge on your bill, but it does not replace your electric utility.



Supply


An electricity supplier selected by Valley Green Energy buys electricity for you.

Delivery

Your utility (Eversource or National Grid) continues to deliver your electricity.

Customer

You receive electricity with no change in service.



In Northampton, two key changes to your National Grid electric bill:

- 1. Your electricity supplier will appear as First Point-Valley **Green Energy NHM.**
- 2. Your electricity supply price will change to a Valley Green Energy price.

In Amherst and Pelham, two key changes to your Eversource electric bill:

- 1. Your electricity supplier will appear as:
 - Amherst: First Point-Valley Green Energy AMH.
 - Pelham: First Point-Valley Green Energy PLM.
- 2. Your electricity supply price will change to a Valley Green Energy price.

Please note: If you have Eversource's Budget Billing, it will no longer apply to your supply charge.

Will NOT change!

Your electric utility continues to:

- **Deliver your electricity** with no interruption and address power outages.
- Send your electric bill and accept bill payments (this is the only electric bill you will receive as a participant).
- Provide a low-income discount if you currently receive that benefit. You will also continue to receive fuel assistance.

If you are participating in community solar, or you are receiving net metering credits or incentive payments for electricity produced by solar panels on your property, you will continue to receive your credits or incentive payments as a participant in Valley Green Energy with no change in how they are calculated. Their calculation is not connected to your electricity supply price.
